#### **RILEY BROWN - 2023 Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship Winner**

Our 2023 Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship was awarded to Riley Brown for his continual outstanding performances across both Instrumental and Piano Sections of the Taree and District Eisteddfod.

Riley began playing in the Eisteddfod at age 7 performing in 6 sections achieving first place in every one. Since that time Riley had performed in Concert Band, solo clarinet, Jazz Band, digital piano and classical piano winning a number of Championship and Scholarship awards including three Smile Scholarships, competing in as many as 24 sections during the year. Riley was awarded many placings across classical, jazz and pop genres.

"The Eisteddfod has been the best opportunity for practicing my performance skills and learning to cope with the demands of playing as a soloist. It encourages a competitor to explore music of different genres and to play also as an ensemble member."

Riley's three Smile Scholarship funds were invested into his music studies including master classes, attendance at music camps and lessons with Sydney Conservatorium Tutors, opening doors to opportunities on even larger stages.

"The confidence and skills I learnt across 10 years at the Eisteddfod prepared me for my yearly music exams, and helped me achieve positions in ensembles that performed at a number of concert venues around Australia including the Sydney Opera House."

"I would encourage any young musician to compete as much as they can at the Eisteddfod. The more you do the better you

become at handling the anxieties that come with performing. It doesn't get easier, but you learn how to cope with it, and you are less likely to do a performance that is affected by your nerves."

"But the best part is sharing your music with other musicians your age who live around you, and sometime making connections with people from outside the area. We learn from each other. It's a safe and supportive place to practice performance craft."

After winning his Piano Championship last year and taking home the Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship, Riley has decided to not compete in 2024 and focus on his HSC studies and change his focus to playing bass guitar across the local live music scene.

"I'm ready to explore some new avenues of performance. But I'll miss the Eisteddfod. The friendships I made were with people who loved music in the same way I did. Thank you to everyone involved in putting the Eisteddfod together not just for the last 10 years but forever. My mum, and my brothers and sisters grew up performing in this event also. It takes a great deal of effort and sponsorship, and a year of preparation. You're all amazing.

## **Special Awards**

#### THE DENVA BIRD MEMORIAL AWARD FOR THE MOST PROMISING PERFORMER.

A \$250 cash award will be awarded to the competitor judged by the adjudicator to be the most promising performer in the Speech and Drama Section of this year's eisteddfod.

#### **ROMA LIGGINS SCHOLARSHIP**

A \$2500 scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding competitor in the 2024 eisteddfod. One competitor will be chosen by the adjudicator from each of the six sections. The committee will then choose the successful competitor. Their name will be announced at the Grand Concert.

#### SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$500 will be given to a talented competitor in the Speech and Drama section who has been nominated by the adjudicator but has not won the Roma Liggins Scholarship.

#### TAREE ARTS COUNCIL AWARD FOR A PROMISING PERFORMER 12 YRS & UNDER

A \$50 cash award and trophy will be awarded to a competitor 12 years or under judged by the adjudicator to be showing potential as a Speech and Drama performer. This award is funded by Taree Arts Council.

#### **ENCOURAGEMENT AWARDS**

An eisteddfod award of two \$50 cash prizes is given to one female and one male performer who are judged to be outstanding in a duologue or group.

Encouragement awards of \$20 for each age group will be made available throughout this year's Speech and Drama Section donated by McDonalds.

Mid Coast Council donates a \$50 encouragement award.

A \$20 award for the Most Memorable Performance donated by Charlotte Wilkins All special awards are made by the adjudicator.


