RILEY BROWN - 2023 Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship Winner

Our 2023 Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship was awarded to Riley Brown for his continual outstanding performances across both Instrumental and Piano Sections of the Taree and District Eisteddfod.

Riley began playing in the Eisteddfod at age 7 performing in 6 sections achieving first place in every one. Since that time Riley had performed in Concert Band, solo clarinet, Jazz Band, digital piano and classical piano winning a number of Championship and Scholarship awards including three Smile Scholarships, competing in as many as 24 sections during the year. Riley was awarded many placings across classical, jazz and pop genres.

"The Eisteddfod has been the best opportunity for practicing my performance skills and learning to cope with the demands of playing as a soloist. It encourages a competitor to explore music of different genres and to play also as an ensemble member."

Riley's three Smile Scholarship funds were invested into his music studies including master classes, attendance at music camps and lessons with Sydney Conservatorium Tutors, opening doors to opportunities on even larger stages.

"The confidence and skills I learnt across 10 years at the Eisteddfod prepared me for my yearly music exams, and helped me achieve positions in ensembles that performed at a number of concert venues around Australia including the Sydney Opera House."

"I would encourage any young musician to compete as much as they can at the Eisteddfod. The more you do the better you become at handling the anxieties that come with performing. It doesn't get easier, but you learn how to cope with it, and you

are less likely to do a performance that is affected by your nerves." "But the best part is sharing your music with other musicians your age who live around you, and sometime making connections with people from outside the area. We learn from each other. It's a safe and supportive place to practice performance craft."

After winning his Piano Championship last year and taking home the Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship, Riley has decided to not compete in 2024 and focus on his HSC studies and change his focus to playing bass guitar across the local live music scene.

"I'm ready to explore some new avenues of performance. But I'll miss the Eisteddfod. The friendships I made were with people who loved music in the same way I did. Thank you to everyone involved in putting the Eisteddfod together not just for the last 10 years but forever. My mum, and my brothers and sisters grew up performing in this event also. It takes a great deal of effort and sponsorship, and a year of preparation. You're all amazing.

Special Awards

Special Awards: A sum of \$250 and the Denva Bird Memorial Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the competitor, judged by the adjudicator, to be one of the most promising vocalists in this eisteddfod.

Stage Door scholarship: A scholarship for \$300 worth of tuition will be made available to a competitor showing potential. This scholarship is funded by the canteen, so please support us in this endeavor.

The Kevin Dodd Memorial Perpetual Award: \$100 to be presented to the best local male high school singer and \$100 to be presented to the best local female high school singer, donated by the Manning River Lions Club.

MidCoast Council Awards: 5 awards of \$50 vouchers for contestants, to purchase music or items from Bass and Blues Music Store, as encouragement awards.

Special Scholarships: A scholarship of \$500 has been donated for an outstanding performer in the Vocal Section. This will be chosen by the adjudicator and presented at the Grand Concert. This award is only given in the years that a vocal performer does not win the Roma Liggins Perpetual Scholarship.

Smile Scholarships: Two Smile Scholarships to the value of \$1000 each are to be awarded by the adjudicator. These are made available to two very talented competitors, to enable them to attend summer schools, music camps, master classes or private tuition with specialist teachers. Winning a Smile Scholarship does not necessarily gain a place in the Grand Concert.


